Logistical Details

Drop-Off: Participants should be dropped off promptly by 8:30am, but no earlier than 8:15am as our directors and or counselor may not be there before that time.

Location: This year's workshop will be held at Hogan Auditorium in Danvers (450 Maple Street).

Pick-Up: Participants of the Young Artist program should be picked up at 12:00PM. Participants cannot be released to anyone that has not been authorized by their legal parent/guardian. Late pickups will result in a \$20.00 fine for each 15 minutes after 12:00PM that we are providing care.

Exception: Friday, the kids will arrive at 10am and stay for the day to put the entire show together. They will need to bring a lunch that day. Their performance at 6:30pm and will go home with their family after the performance. A pizza dinner will be provided before the show.

What to Bring to the Workshop

SNACKS: Each participant should bring 1 snack and their own reusable water bottle, labeled with their name, which we can refill as needed. Please be sure all are clearly marked or uniquely identifiable to your child. Absolutely no soda or fruit drinks.

CLOTHING: We advise that all participants wear shorts and t-shirt or tank top with closed toed shoes- no sandals. There will likely be various art projects (for the set and props) and we strongly suggest that good clothes be kept at home and that your child wear and bring "play clothes" to the workshop that won't matter if it gets paint, papier-mâché paste or glue on it.

TOWEL/BLANKET: Campers should bring a towel or blanket to sit on during lunch and outside activities. Remember to put your name on it.

SUN PROTECTION: Please send your child to the workshop with their own sunscreen (SPF 15 or higher). When weather permits, we will be doing some of the learning sessions and rehearsals outdoors, so it is important to send sunscreen, a sun hat and/or sunglasses.

SCRIPT: Students will need a folder or three-ring binder to keep their script in. Blank paper and pencils are also required everyday. Please make sure that they bring their binder home to review lines and then back to the workshop each day. Please write their name on everything they bring.

BACKPACK: Please send everything in a labeled backpack with your child. This will significantly reduce the number of lost items, since everything will be in one place.
